

Behavior Analytics Quick Guide

Behavior Analytics, School Tab

Verify Behavior Analytics has been enhanced to include five new Operational Data Views for a quick visual reference of a school's disciplinary environment. Parameters for the views are customizable by day, week, or month timeframes. Each color coded icon can be drilled down to a bar chart or data extract view. Additional grids displaying the SCC Violation detail are broken out by level 1-3 violations and level 4-6 violations for the selected date parameter. Behavior Analytics can be found by clicking on **Incident Management** on the top menu bar and then by selecting **Behavior Analytics** from the drop-down menu.

Selecting a Date Range

- 1. Click on a date range to change the data displayed. Default is **Today**. In the example below **This Week** is selected.
- 2. Select the group of Students to view. Default is **Active Students**. Inactive students are students who are no longer enrolled in your school.



Summary Charts

The five Operational Data Views available are Frequent Flier Students, Level 1, 2 and 3; SCC Violations Infractions by Code, Level 1, 2, and 3; SCC Violations Infractions by Location, Level 4, 5, and 6; SCC Violations Infractions by Code, Level 4, 5, and 6; and SCC Violations Infractions by Location. The [] icon for each chart is color coded to indicate how high or low the grand total is for the view.

1. Click on the [icon to generate the chart.



2. The chart will display the data for the date range you selected. Click on the Data tab to see the data in a grid.

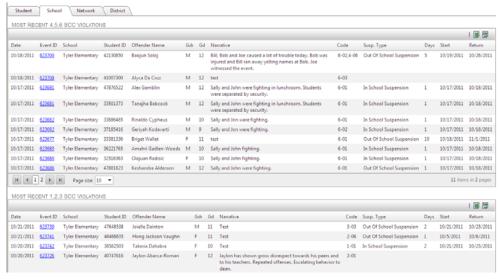

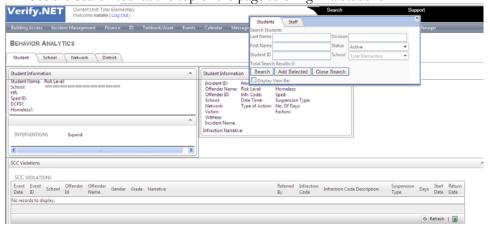
SCC Violation Grids

There are two grids below the Operational Data Views that display the Level 4, 5, and 6 SCC Violations and the Level 1, 2, and 3 SCC Violations that have occurred at the school for the date range selected. These grids can be exported to Excel or CSV.



Navigating to Behavior Analytics, Student Tab

- 1. Click on the **Student** tab.
- 2. Use the Search tool at the top of the page to bring in a student.



Navigating to the Event Detail Report

1. Click on an Event ID in one of the grids.
