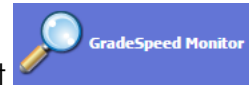



VIEWING GRADE CHANGES

After the grading period ends, any changes or modifications to grades must be entered by the school administrator or grade coordinator in IMPACT SIM. Once grade changes are made in IMPACT SIM, the user may view the edited grades in Gradebook in the following three places:

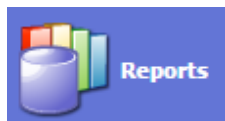


1. **Gradespeed Monitor.** Log into Gradebook and select . Then, select the desired student and the appropriate cycle in which the changes were made in SIM. Grades that have been adjusted in SIM will be highlighted in GREEN to reflect that it is a different grade from what was originally entered in the teacher's gradebook.

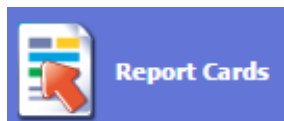

Notice the Writing Standards grade that was changed to a 'C' in SIM is now highlighted in GREEN. This indicates that a grade change has been made in SIM and has successfully moved back to Gradebook.

2. **Regenerated Report Card or Progress Report.** Once a grade change has been made in SIM, an administrator may regenerate the Report Card in Gradebook to view the revised change.

GROWTH IN KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

The following grading codes are used to report your child's achievement

The Chicago Public Schools uses a standards-based curriculum. The letter grades below are explicitly linked to the Illinois Learning Standards. The letter grades indicate the student's progress in meeting grade-level standards.

A - Substantially exceeds the standard	D - Less than acceptable performance on standard
B - Exceeds the standard	F - Does not meet the standard
C - Meets the standard	I - Indicates an area not to be graded at this time

Each grade represents your child's achievement for one 10-week reporting period on that standard. An average grade of the four grades is recorded at the end for the school year in the column headed FINAL. The grade corresponds to the grade on your child's permanent record.

Notice the corrected grade is reflected on the report card after it is regenerated.

- Cummulative Grades Tab within the CURRENT cycle of teacher's gradebook.** Adjusted grades will be displayed under the appropriate cycle column within the teacher's current Gradebook, under the Cumulative Grades tab. Do not change the cycle back to a previous cycle to view the adjusted grades – you will not see them there. Teachers will see modified grades from a previous cycle only when the view is set to the current cycle.
