Background

In February of 2016, the Chicago Board of Education amended the Chicago Public Schools' **Minimum High School Graduation Requirements Policy** (605.3A), beginning with the Freshman class in SY2016-2017. The major changes were made to:

1. Social Science
2. Career Education
3. *Fine Arts
4. Service Learning

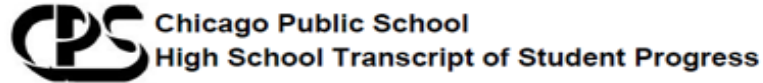
