

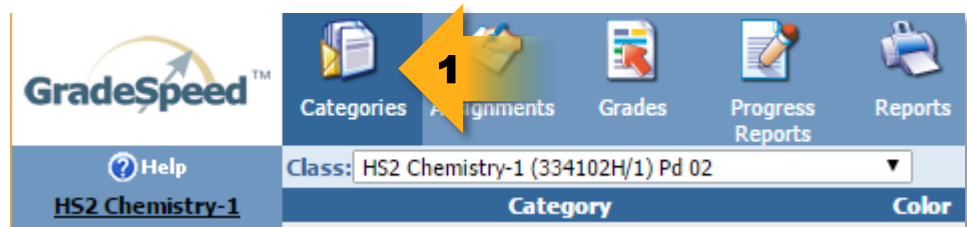
GRADEBOOK: MODIFYING GRADING CATEGORIES

Quick Start Guide

This Quick Start Guide will take you through the process of modifying grading categories for each section in your gradebook. Categories come predefined, but the majority of teachers can edit them.

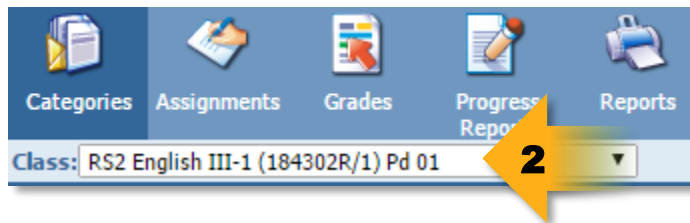
Open the Categories Screen

1. In the menu bar, click “Categories.”



Select a Class

2. In the Class dropdown, select the desired class.



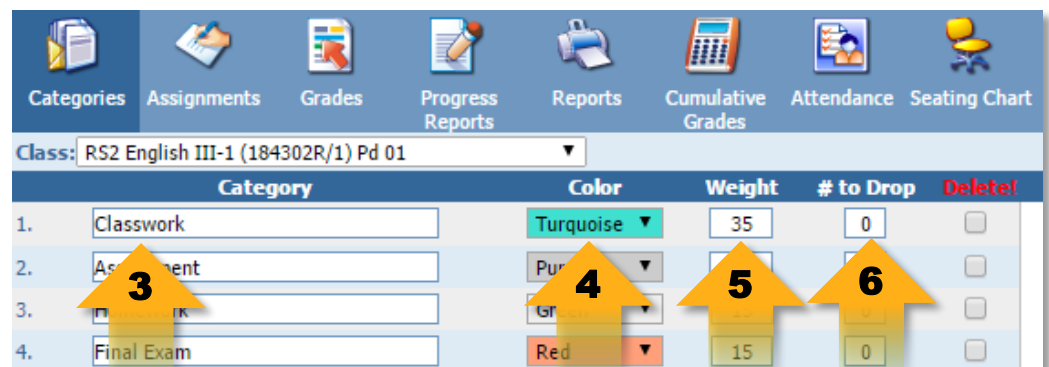
Modify a Category

3. Type in the name of your first category.

4. Select your desired color.

5. Indicate the percent which this category will count towards the final grade.

6. If you want to drop low assignments by category, indicate how many here.



Note: Some schools elect to pre-define and lock-down teacher categories, preventing edits at the class level.

Create Additional Categories

7. Repeat steps 3-6 to create any additional categories.

8. Ensure values in **Weight** column add up to 100.
